Katydid Crocker: (Katy, 25) Davey's niece, visiting for summer, practically Betsy's servant - yet suspicious behavior - she wants \$\$ to win a man - sweetly flirtatious.

Sheriff Luke Lasso: Hero, cute and play on character Woody, from Toy Story. Luke loves ropes and is tying knots constantly. He's interested in Clara and running for re-election.

Poster Lady: Makes announcements (mostly in rhyme) -- keeps the mood lively and audience participation booming!
